## What is the Patient Participation Group or PPG?

A Patient Participation Group (PPG) is a group of people who are patients of the surgery and want to help it work as well as it can for patients, doctors and staff. The NHS requires every practice to have a PPG.



## Why should I join?

You have been to the surgery as a patient, parent, carer or friend.

Your experiences matter and you can bring different ideas to the surgery to help us treat patients better or to improve what we do in some way.

You will also gain a better understanding of the NHS, and gather feedback from other patients.

## How often do the group meet?

We aim to meet every 2 months as a PPG. We vary the meeting times throughout the year to try and give everyone a chance to attend. We appreciate you are busy and may not be able to make it every meeting. We encourage PPG members to submit agenda items ahead of the meeting, this can be done by email, and we will feedback to you via the meeting minutes.

## Primary Care Network PPG

This is about our GP practices working together, sharing ideas and developing new ways of working. As a group of 5 practices we are committed to work more closely together

We are part of the wider PCN PPG along with 4 other local practices. As we grow our services a number of these will be shared across the practices.

Representatives from each Practice PPG meet quarterly to share ideas and feedback on how the network is progressing.

## What projects are the PPG working on?

We established our **Wide Way Walkers in May 2019**. Patients meet at the practice on the first Thursday of every month at 11am and set off on a walk around the local green spaces. It's a great chance to get outdoors, explore the community and meet new people.

We are also launching a **Gardening Club** in Summer 2020. We will be raising funds through our coffee morning and a raffle to purchase tools, plants and seeds for the community garden.

Our Warm & Well Event with Wimbledon Guild in November 2019 was a hit with our patients. Local providers came together to tell patients all about the fantastic services available and gave practical advice about keeping healthy during the winter months.

We will also be hosting regular **coffee mornings** at the practice promoting local services and workshops on managing long term conditions and minor ailments.
